Hats: TBGO logo black baseball hat and Santa hat. No dirty hats, worn out Hats or hats with horrible sweat on them as it looks bad for the TV.

Socks: Black only. No mixed colors with the black.

Belts: Black only as any other color is not acceptable.

Slacks: The official TBGO pants are all black. Not grey or faded black or Navy. Jeans of any type that are black are not acceptable. Definitely no cargo pants with patch pockets. No patch pockets on any slacks. Again, pants need to be full length.

Shoes: Black only. No mix of white and black. Best to wear a black shoe that are comfortable to march in, plus a rubber-soled shoe is recommended.
